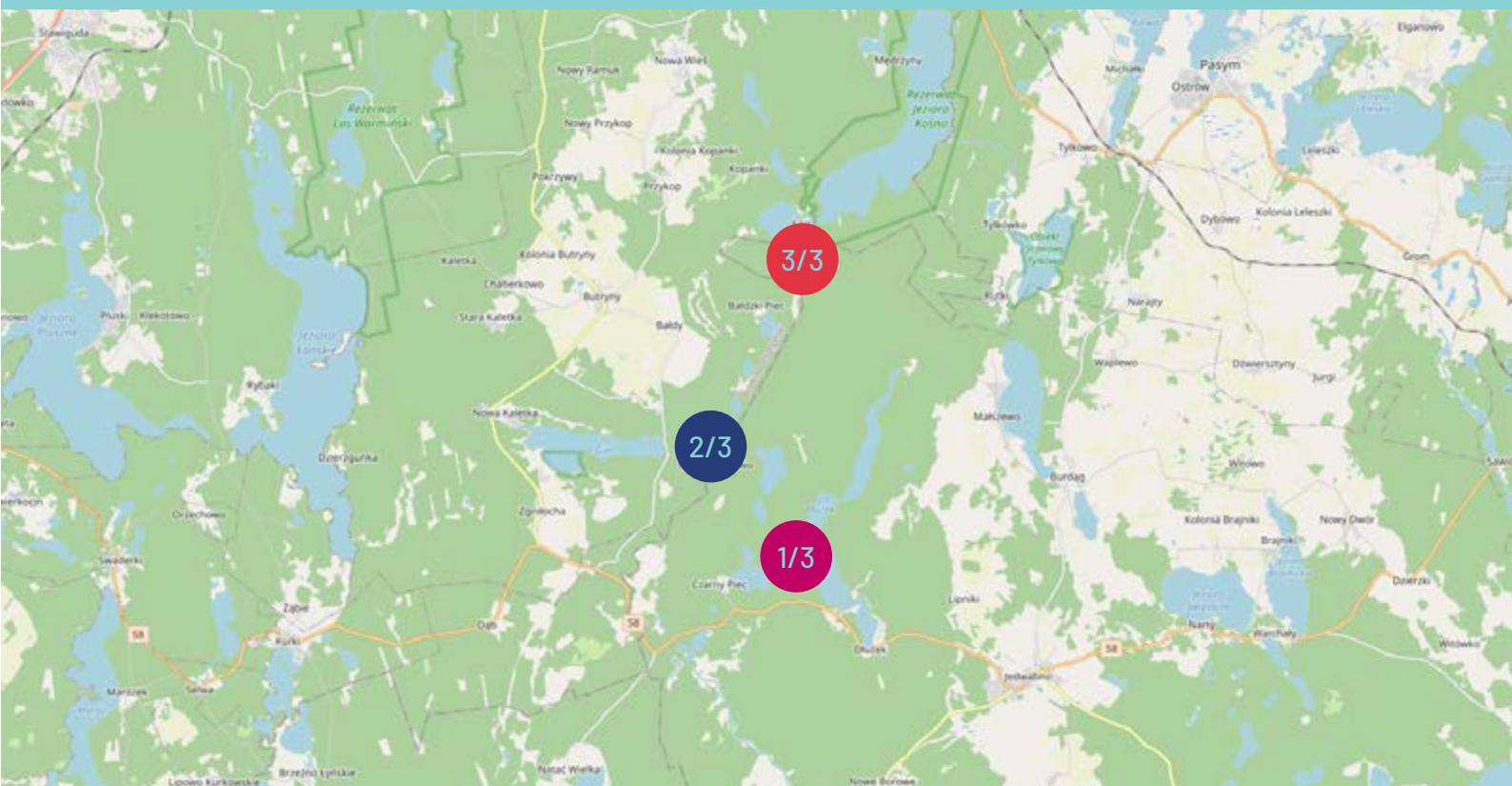


# ABSTRACT

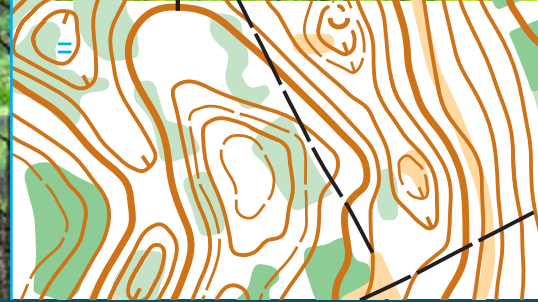
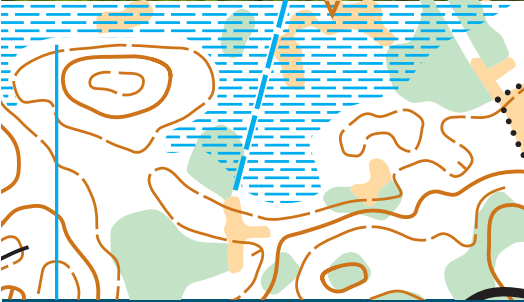

## WATER

There will be self-service refreshment points for longest classes competitors during 2nd and 3rd stage. Refreshment points will be located on a leg between controls and marked on the map.

## START PROCEDURE

SI clear before start boxes

-3' SI check

-2' control descriptions

-1' maps (athlete can take the map in the moment of the start - beep on the clock)

80-110 m marked route from timed start to start triangle

## TIME LIMIT

Stage 1 120 minutes

Stage 2 180 minutes

Stage 3 120 minutes

## 1ST STAGE START

During the 1st stage Enka, Rodzinna, Krótka and KM10 classes will have the start located in the Event Center. During the stages 2nd and 3rd the start of these classes is located in the same place as the start of the remaining classes.

## KM10

During 1st stage there will be a short marked route to one of control points on KM10 courses. It will be marked with a marked route symbol on the map (dotted line instead of solid line) and with orange ribbons in the forest.

## OPEN CLASSES

There is no start time assignment for open classes, you can start in the first two hours of the start time (00-120').

Participants competing in both sport classes and open classes with children are asked to do the sport classes course first in order to maintain fair play rules.



## MARKED COURSES

Enka and Rodzinna courses will be marked with orange ribbons.

Two maps will be prepared at the start for each registered competitor in Rodzinna class - one for the child, the other one for the parent.

## PUNCHING SYSTEM

SPORTident system in AIR+ mode will be used for punching during the event.

## CONTROL DESCRIPTIONS

Printed on the map and separate descriptions available at start.



## CHASING START

3rd stage will include a chasing start for all classes (apart from open classes). Competitors in each class will start in accordance with the following rules:

- the best competitor after two stages in each class starts as the first one,
- the next competitors in each class start according to the time losses to the leader (up to 30 minutes loss),
- competitors who are more than 30 minutes behind the leader after three stages start in the interval start.

## CAFETERIA

There will be a cafeteria during each stage at the Event Center. Simple barbecue dishes and drinks will be offered. Payment only in cash in Polish złoty.

## OUT-OF-BOUNDS AREA

In the area of 2nd stage there is a peat bog which is a refuge for protected species, therefore this area is excluded from use during the event. It will be marked on the map with the symbol **709 Out-of-bounds area** and entering there is forbidden.

## ENVIRONMENT

Respecting the surrounding nature is extremely important, therefore during the competition we will try to reduce the negative impact of our event on the environment as much as possible - we will try to minimize the amount of generated waste and replace plastic with paper products where possible. You can also help us with this - bring your own reusable cups for water at the finish line.

# KID'S ZONE

Toilets will be available only in Event Center.

There will be Kid's zone with attractions for the youngest organized at each stage at the Event Center. Also, a special Miniknat course for children located next to the Event Center will be available. Both Kid's zone and Miniknat will be free of charge and available to all willing children without prior registration.

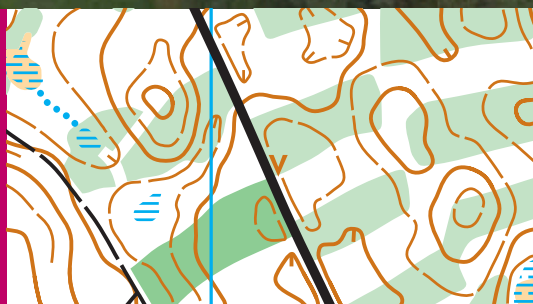

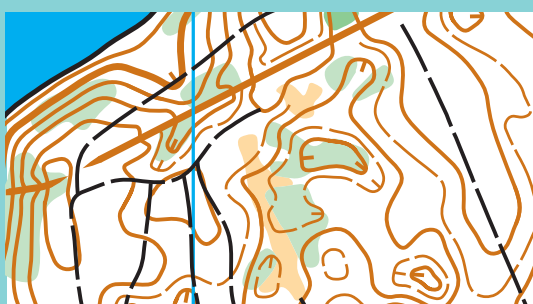
## LOCATION

Meadow by Czarne Lake

During the first stage, you will face fast terrain with smooth and non-obvious micro-relief. It will be crucial to slam on the brakes at the right moments to avoid making mistakes. Moreover, at this stage there will be some history in the background - the woods are full of remnants of defensive fortifications from World War II, mainly bunkers buried in the forest wilderness. In short, it will be a **fast** and **tricky** stage, perfect for getting to know the characteristics of the masurian terrain.

The terrain of the second stage is completely different from the first one. The relief is not as complicated, but in return you will experience great variability in the vegetation and numerous marshes. When describing the second stage it is impossible not to mention the finish line located on the beach of Gim Lake. It is known to be one of the cleanest lakes in Poland and always dazzles with its azure water. As befits a decent classic - it will be a **long** and **epic** race.
